


Tess's Dress




Tess is in class.

Is the dress a mess?






Snakes and Ladders

Aim: Be the first to reach number 100.

How to play:

1. The player throws the die on his\her turn.

2. Then, the player picks a word from the 'word list' of the current lesson (you may add words of the previous lessons too).

- If the player reads the word correctly, he continues on the board the number of spaces on the die.

- If the player does not read the word correctly, he does not continue on the board.

- If the player reaches a ladder, s/he needs to read another word. Should s/he read the word correctly, s/he can go up the ladder.

- If the player reaches a snake; if s/he reads the word correctly s/he is saved from going down the snake. And if s/he doesn't read the word correctly, s/he must slide down the snake.

3. The first player that reaches number 100 on the board wins the game!
