

Lotto Game

Goals

- 1) The words are chosen for a specific letter: Practicing reading, listening comprehension for a specific letter. (Example below is for Lesson 82, the sounds of the **ch** combination.)
- 2) Vocabulary practice
- 3) Spelling practice

Preparation

Choose a set of words containing a particular letter/combination/sound. Prepare two boards, each with different words, in a table format as shown below. (The examples here have 18 words each, or 36 words total.) Print two copies of each board; cut up one copy of each board into word cards. Mix the two boards' word cards together.

The example here, for Hickey Lesson 82, reviews the (k), (sh), and (ch) sounds of the "ch" combination, and uses fairly high-level words, so might be suitable for high-school students. You could prepare a game for less advanced students with simpler words from the Hickey Word List through the lesson you have reached.

Rules of Play

- 1) In each group of 5 students: 2 teams of 2 students and a speaker
- 2) Each team has a Lotto board.
- 3) The speaker has all the word cards. He takes one card and reads aloud the word and gives the card to the player who has the same word on his Lotto board. The first team to fill in its Lotto board - wins.
- 4) After one game, the speaker takes the place of one player. One player takes the place of the speaker. And the teams exchange their Lotto boards.
- 5) After the second game, player and speaker change their role again. But this time the speaker spells the word and the players have to recognize the word on their big Lotto card.

6) Player and speaker change their role for the last time and the teams their Lotto card. At the end of the game each student would have been the speaker once.

7) More challenge for advanced students

The speaker will explain the word with a sentence. The players have to guess the word. For example for the word chocolate, the speaker will say: something sweet and black that we can eat.
