
A Trip in a Van




We wanted to take a trip.

We prepared some backpacks.




We filled the tank of the van with gas.

Bingo: With and Without Writing Practice

Equipment: a bag in which to mix up bingo cards, about 30 buttons or coins Step 1: Cut up the plain word cards. Step 2

If you have time for writing.

- Give the student the bingo board without words.
- Student goes through the cards, finds the matching picture, and copies the word into the bingo square in the empty space below the correct picture.

If you don't have time for writing.

- Give the student one of the bingo boards with words.
- Step 3: Take the remaining bingo board with words for yourself.

Step 4: Pull a word card out of a hat, both players find the word on their bingo boards, and cover it with a button. Repeat. The first one with 4 buttons in a row in any direction wins.
