
Jay Plays with Clay




It is Sunday evening.

Guess the Word

Materials: You will need two copies of the game board and two colors of chips or markers (buttons, beans). You will also need a folder or some other kind of divider to put up between the boards so neither player will be able to see the opponent's board.

Play: Erect the divider. Each player places a chip on one word in each line. The object is to guess the word in each line that your opponent has "marked."

The first player guesses a word. If s/he is right, s/he will wait until the next turn and try to guess a word from the second line. If s/he doesn't guess correctly, s/he puts a different color marker on the wrong word so s/he knows not to ask that word again. Then the second player takes a turn guessing. Continue until one player has successfully guessed all the marked words on the opponent's board.
